Thursday, July 22, promises to be an intriguing day with much to explore and discover. And of course throw in a little shopping and great fellowship, and you have a “typical” ACCE tour day! The bus leaves at 9:00 am from the hotel

The tour will begin at the Old Penitentiary for a guided tour around this over 100 year Historic Site. The facility was built in 1870 and housed over 13,000 convicts during its century on operation. The tour includes the cell blocks, yards, death row and gallows chambers, so be prepared to behave yourself!



The bus will then take participants to the Idaho Botanicals Gardens for a guided tour around this living museum of nature. The garden boasts native and exotic plants groupings, theme and display gardens as well as extensive water features. You will have time to visit the Garden Store that is a source for unusual garden tools, horticulture-related finds and unique gifts.

The last stop of the day will be the World Center for the Birds of Prey. A guided tour of this facility and also entrance and guided tour around the Falconry Archive Center and a love bird exhibition are included at this stop. This center is the world headquarters for the Peregrine Falcon rehabilitation efforts and houses over 200 raptors at this facility.

After a wonderful day exploring the beauty of Boise, we will head back to the hotel with an estimated arrival of 4:30.
