You will then tour the highlights of the city of Phoenix, past to present, including an overview of the Central Corridor, the Capital Building, Chase Field, the government and entertainment district and the exclusive outlying areas of Paradise Valley and Scottsdale. While in Scottsdale, you'll visit the famous 5th Avenue shops in downtown, offering a wide selection of Southwestern specialty stores, unique boutiques and national art galleries.
