COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a construction-related degree program, and have at least one-term remaining in a course of study leading to a degree or an associated degree in a construction-related field. **High school seniors are not eligible.**
- B. Applicant must desire a career in a construction-related field.
- C. Applicant must be enrolled for twelve credit hours.
- D. Applicant must have current cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered for awards.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted to the Foundation and postmarked by April 1st. Please attach in the order shown:

- A. Completed and signed Application Form.
- B. Official transcript of grades for 3 most recent semesters.
- C. Extracurricular Activities listing.
- D. Employment History listing.

AWARDS

- A. Scholarships are not automatically renewed. Students will be considered for subsequent awards if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, and continued enrollment and good standing in a college program leading to a degree or associated degree in a construction-related field.
- B. Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the NAWIC Atlanta Scholarship Foundation Awards Committee. They will consider applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need. All applicants will be notified of their status after the Awards Committee meeting in May.
- C. All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the NAWIC Atlanta Scholarship Foundation. The representative will either be a member of the Awards Committee, the Chair or other person as appointed by the majority of the aforementioned members. All semi-finalists will be notified of their status after evaluations are complete (generally May/June).
- D. Checks will be sent directly to the winners in September upon receipt of evidence of registration. However, proof of matriculation for the next school term, and other information as designated by the Foundation, is required prior to checks being mailed.

SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION

NASF offers undergraduate scholarships once a year. The deadline is April 1st. Applications postmarked after the deadline date will not be considered.
