# AMERICAN COUNCIL FOR CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION

The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for both 4-year baccalaureate degree programs and two-year associate degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology. The Council offers accreditation for Master Degree Programs and Recognition of Continuing Education courses for Non-Degree Programs.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor's professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China, the Canadian Technological Accreditation Board (CTAB), and The Chartered Institute of Builders (CIOB) in the United Kingdom. The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards' comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.

As ACCE continues its mission of promoting quality construction education and as ACCE begins its 40<sup>th</sup> year in operation, we are in the midst of

change. However, the one thing that remains constant are the people who bring their passion for education. We have had many who have contributed their time and talents and no one more than Mark Benjamin. Mark and his son Luke pass away on Sunday, September 29, 2013 in a tragic accident in Santa Monica, CA. Mark was a friend of anyone he met and was a wonderful part of what ACCE is and where it is going. He will be missed.

Our effort in making these changes is in support of our mission and to continue our effort to remain current in our body of knowledge and to improve its processes. The construction market is improving and employment of our graduates is much better, with most programs having 100% employment again.

The Standards Committee is completing its work on the new Outcome-Based Assessment standards and processes which the committee will vote on at the February meeting. It will be a final committee vote. Then the new Standards will be sent to the full Board for approval at the July 2014 meeting. Pilot testing and full implementation is scheduled to begin in the fall of 2015, culminating in full implementation by the fall

2016 time frame. This has been an arduous task for the many involved and there is plenty of work remaining, for the implementation effort is no small task.

The Board provided final approval of the new By-laws that restructure our governance at the July 2013 meeting. These changes will make us more responsive to our stakeholders, providing the nomination of the educators and industry trustees directly by the programs and industry representatives. The reorganization also provides the Board the chance to focus on broader topics and gives the Executive Committee more responsibility at the daily operations level.

The Industry Advisory Workshop was held in Baton Rouge with great success. This is the fourth year of the workshop and it continues to be a strength and support for our Industry partners and to the programs that benefit from the improved focus from industry.

ACCE awarded 2 scholarships in 2013: Mike Duff from TAMU and Heidi Wagner from Minnesota-Twin Cities. These 2 industry folks are moving toward their PhD's and will most certainly become faculty. The Dupree scholarship program has continued to be a successful, albeit small program.

The Founder's Award was given to Skanska, Bert Fonseca and their Orlando Office. The support that Skanska has given the program at Seminole State and other programs in the Florida area has shown the industry how to have an impact on

a college and its students.

During the fiscal year of 2012-2013, the Accreditation Committee was busy reviewing 16 Visiting Team Reports (4 of which were new programs) and reviewed 34 progress reports.

We currently have accredited 71 4-year programs; 12 2-year programs; and 2-master degree programs, with 9 4-year and 5 2-year programs in candidate status.

During my 2 years as Vice-President, I came to have a better understanding of the complexity and the promise of ACCE. Now as the Board Chair, I hope to implement the strategic elements that have been developed and will strive to provide ACCE the vision and guidance to accomplish its mission of promoting quality construction education.

None of this will be possible without your dedication, vision and passion to bring about the improvements we all deem necessary to meet the needs of our stakeholders. Thanks to all who support ACCE's work.
