PRESIDENT'S REPORT



The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is the promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education. Specifically, ACCE's primary focus is to accredit construction education programs in colleges and universities, as well as construction workforce education programs and Institutions that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE was organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors (AIC), the constructors' professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction (ASC). ACCE enjoys the support of many North American building and contracting associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs of highly qualified entry-level management personnel in the construction profession.

The Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), based in Washington, DC, provides oversight of ACCE as the accrediting agency for the four-year baccalaureate degree, two-year associate degree, and master's degree programs in construction science, construction management, and construction technology programs. In October 2022, CHEA approved its recognition of ACCE for seven more years. In July 2023, CHEA approved a new Scope of Services for ACCE.

The CHEA approval allows two changes to our Scope of Services. The first is to provide accreditation services for single-purpose Institutions that offer associate degree programs in construction-related occupational education. The second change allows ACCE to provide accreditation for international construction degree programs. We have completed the accreditation of two single-purpose institutions, Western States College of Construction in Denver, CO, and the College of Mechanical Systems and Technology (a.k.a. 290Tech) located in Tualatin, OR. Also, the Board approved the first international degree program in South America, the MS Degree Program in construction management at the Universidad Peruana de Ciencias Aplicadas in Lima, Peru.

Our Accreditation Committee and Visiting Teams were busy this past year. Based on their efforts and recommendations, the ACCE Board of Trustees granted reaccreditation to 14 existing construction degree programs and initial accreditation to two new degree programs. There are now 102 ACCE-accredited programs in the United States, Canada, and Peru.

Based on requests from our industry constituents, ACCE offers a Professional Development Certification (PDC) Program. This program aims to recognize industry-related professional development training provided by educational institutions, industry associations, and private companies that meet ACCE criteria for certification. There are now 17 ACCE-certified professional development programs.

We have one new Sustaining Association Member. Mr. Jeremy Hurley will represent the Home Builders Institute (HBI), the workforce development arm of the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB).

We have started incorporating HVACR programs into ACCE. ITEC Training and Education Center in Rochester, NY, has an accelerated Residential Heating and Air Conditioning training program that has received our Professional Development Certification. There are now three HVACR degree programs that have applied for degree accreditation. Two programs are at Pennsylvania College of Technology (an AAS Degree and a BS Degree), where we are sending a Visiting Team in October 2025. The AAS Degree Program at St. Philips College in San Antonio, TX, will have a Visiting Team review their application and Self-Evaluation Study in the Spring 2026 semester.

The Teaching and Learning Practitioners (TLP) Program has successfully launched the pilot programs. The TLP sessions have been presented at three ACCE Conferences as well as a workshop for the Keystone Chapter of ABC located in Manheim, PA. We are now planning for additional TLP sessions to be delivered at our Institutions and members' locations. Created by Dr. Tony Lamanna, Dr. John Tingerthal, and Professor Tom Leathem, this Program aims to assist new instructors of courses and training programs to become fully competent and confident in their teaching skills.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China and the Chartered Institute of Builders (CIOB) in the United Kingdom. These agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA and CIOB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the exact equivalency for NBCMA and CIOB accredited Degree Programs. This past year, we renewed our agreement with CIOB. The Board created the International Programs Taskforce, led by Dr. Francois Jacobs, which will explore other possible reciprocity agreements and potential foreign CM degree programs for accreditation.

Our recent successes are a direct result of the dedication and passion of our more than 200 volunteers at ACCE.

BOARD CHAIR'S REPORT



On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I am pleased to present the 2024–2025 ACCE Annual Report. I extend my sincere appreciation to all my colleagues for their active participation in committee meetings—both virtual and in-person—throughout the year. Your commitment of time and expertise in supporting continuous improvement and quality assurance in construction education at ACCE-accredited programs is commendable.

ACCE continues to grow stronger and expand its influence in advancing excellence in construction education. Under the leadership of our President, Steve Nellis, we have relentlessly pursued new opportunities aligned with our expanded scope, as confirmed by CHEA in their August 1, 2025, letter. Thanks to Steve's efforts, ACCE now has 13 Sustaining Association partners. We remain deeply grateful to the many volunteers from industry, academia, and associations who have shared their time and talents in support of our mission.

In July 2024, ACCE held a successful Annual Meeting in Denver, Colorado. Before the Conference, CHEA confirmed ACCE's scope expansion request, allowing us to accredit single-purpose associate degree-granting institutions offering degrees in construction-related occupational education. ACCE accredited its second single-purpose institution by April 2025, fulfilling CHEA's criteria for the expanded scope. The Construction Workforce Education Committee is currently mentoring several programs in the pipeline for both programmatic and institutional accreditation.

In February 2025, we hosted the Midyear Meeting in Las Colinas, Texas, which included the inaugural Construction Industry Forum, coordinated by the newly renamed Industry Partnership Committee. Led by Paul Mattingly, the Forum welcomed many first-time participants. The Committee has since established three subcommittees—Industry Development, Industry Engagement, and Industry Forum—to enhance its performance and outreach.

I would like to express my gratitude to the Awards and Scholarship Committee and its Chair, Ms. Karima Simmons, for their leadership. The committee recommended a \$5,000 scholarship awarded to Mr. Raffael Hernandez, a Ph.D. student at the University of Oklahoma. The Committee also suggested renaming the "Hall of Fame" to the "Hall of Distinction" and compiled a list of 25 potential candidates with accompanying data. The Teaching and Learning Practitioner (TLP) Program received outstanding support this year. Kudos to Dr. Tony Lamanna, Tom Leathem, and John Tingerthal for expanding the program's reach. Last November, they presented the TLP Workshop to four instructors at the ABC Keystone Chapter.

ACCE also held its Strategic Planning Retreat in November 2024 in Irving, Texas. This initiative, facilitated by an external expert, included input from accredited program chairs, industry practitioners, Executive Committee members, and Trustees. The resulting 2025 Strategic Plan was formally approved during the 2025 Midyear Meeting.

Looking ahead, two major initiatives are poised to expand the impact of ACCE-accredited programs further:

1. STEM Designation: ACCE is pursuing efforts to designate Construction Management programs under the Department of Homeland Security's STEM fields, which would extend Optional Practical Training for international students. The Board has approved the CIP Designation Task Force's recommendation to nominate CIP Code 52.2001 (Construction Management) in the current nomination cycle.

2. New Program Categories: The Standards Committee, led by Dr. Chuck Berryman, completed the new curriculum standards for the Concrete Industry Management degree programs and updated the SLOs for the AS Degree in Construction Management. We had previously created the curriculum and SLOs for the AS and BS Degree levels in HVACR. The Standards Committee is also formulating two new appendices to Document 103 to enable accreditation of programs in:

- a. Fire and Emergency Disaster Management (FEDM)
- b. Facilities Management (FM)

The 2024–2025 year brought both challenges and transformative opportunities. I am deeply grateful for the unwavering commitment of our volunteers and colleagues who enabled ACCE to fulfill the expanded scope authorized by CHEA in 2023. My heartfelt thanks go to former Board Chairs Dr. John Schaufelberger and Charlie Roesset for their support during my transition. I am also thankful to President Steve Nellis and Dr. Sherry Miller, Manager of Accreditation, Certification, and Membership, for their counsel and assistance throughout the year. Special thanks to Vice Chair Rogers Hunt for his tireless efforts in expanding ACCE's reach and new attendee engagement.

As we celebrate ACCE's 50-year milestone, we proudly launched our new strategic plan in February 2025—one that honors our past and positions us to scale new heights. With clear priorities and a bold vision, we are well-prepared to meet the demands of the future.

We've crossed several significant milestones this year:

- 1. Surpassed 100 accredited programs
- 2. Completed our Strategic Plan
- 3. Accredited our first international CM degree program
- 4. Received CHEA recognition of our ability to accredit single-purpose associate degree institutions
- 5. Continue our progress toward accrediting apprenticeship programs, a critical area for construction workforce development.

These accomplishments would not have been possible without the leadership of President Steve Nellis, Dr. Sherry Miller, and our dedicated consultants, Mr. Chip Mansfield and Mr. Michael Copp. The contributions of our Trustees, Executive Committee members, and volunteers have made an indelible impact.

As we continue to collect and share best practices across ACCE-accredited programs, I'm confident that this will remain a priority for our incoming Chair, Rogers Hunt, and Vice Chair, Dr. Charles Berryman. I'm also thankful to Past President Charlie Roesset and once again to Dr. John Schaufelberger for their continued mentorship and support.

Together, we are shaping the future of construction education. Let's continue to lead quality construction education with purpose and passion.




