


ACCE Programs with the Most Construction Graduates (Last Academic Year)



Summary



- Construction expenditure is expected to grow in 2024
- Students graduating from ACCE Accredited programs are better prepared to enter the construction industry
 - 10 ACCE programs graduate over 111 construction students per year
 - 13 ACCE programs attract over 24 ENR Top 400 each year
- Students graduating from ACCE Accredited programs are better prepared to enter the construction industry
 - 86 % of ENR top 50 Recruit at ACCE Schools
 - ▶ 14 ENR top 400 Recruit in 8 or more ACCE programs
