AMERICAN COUNCIL FOR CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION

The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for both 4-year baccalaureate degree programs and two-year associate degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology. The Council offers accreditation for Master Degree Programs and Recognition of Continuing Education courses for Non-Degree Programs.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor's professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China, the Canadian Technology Accreditation Board (CTAB), and The Chartered Institute of Builders (CIOB) in the United Kingdom. The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards' comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.

As your Board Chair, I have completed my first full year in office and it continues to be a very rewarding experience for me. Thank you for all that you do for ACCE – our accomplishments due to your volunteer efforts have a significant impact on construction education in this country and beyond. We have much to be proud of!



A year ago, I laid out three overriding goals for this time in the history of ACCE:

- Full implementation of the Outcomes Based Standards
- Full Board responsibility for the new Strategic Plan
- Ongoing response to competition from the ASAC accreditation alternative

We are currently at varying stages on each of these efforts. On implementing the Outcomes Based Standards, all programs starting in the fall of 2016 are now being assessed against these new Standards. After a decade of carefully considering these changes, gathering significant industry input, completely rewriting the Standards document, and phasing in the new procedures, ACCE accreditation is now fully based on outcomes rather than prescription. The work continues as multiple committees and task forces assess lessons learned to date and prepare new training to complete the implementation process. We are well on our way to accomplishing this goal.

The Board is taking increasing responsibility for the success of the Strategic Plan. This was one of the major goals of the recent governance reorganization designed to delegate more decisions to other committees so that the Board can focus on long term strategies and directions. The Strategic Planning Committee under the direction of Board Vice Chair Cheryl Goodale has done a good job organizing the key goals and strategies, but the success of the Plan rests

with members of the Board of Trustees. We have had some discussions of the Plan at Board meetings, but a vigilant effort by the Trustees is needed to make this goal a reality.

ACCE's response to the ASAC accreditation alternative has been ongoing. We have worked with the editors of ENR to publish one Viewpoint article and two Letters to the Editor addressing opportunities for industry to work with ACCE and correcting misstatements included in two articles. We have worked with AGC to make them aware of the differences between these alternatives and the advantages of ACCE accreditation to their membership of general and trade contractors. Finally, presentations about ACCE processes are being made at several regional meetings and at the national meeting of ASC. In spite of these efforts, I must report that ACCE has lost five programs since our last report. Though we have also gained two programs, this net loss of three along with the decision of the NAWIC Education Foundation to drop their Association Membership will put a strain on our budget in the coming years. Our efforts to reverse these losses must continue. We currently have 90 programs accredited: 73 Bachelor's, 13 Associate's, and 5 Master's degree programs. And there are 12 Candidate programs moving forward toward successful accreditation.

To address both a Strategic Plan initiative and our response to this competition, the Board approved last July funding to hire a consultant to help us develop and implement a formal Marketing Plan. An RFP was issued and the short-listed firms have been invited to make a final presentation to the Trustees for their selection. This plan will focus on maintaining the current list of accredited programs, converting the current list of Candidate programs, and increasing the participation of both new academic programs and practitioners. We need to develop a clear value proposition of what ACCE brings to academia and to the industry. This effort is extremely important to ACCE's future. As one Trustee said when debating the cost of this initiative, "What is the cost if we do not invest in this effort?"

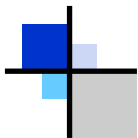
We also want to celebrate other significant accomplishments this year. At our meeting in Orlando, we are holding our 8th annual Industry Advisory Board "Best Practices" Workshop designed to help many IAB members network and find ways to increase their influence on construction education and on ACCE. We are providing Initial Visiting Team Training during Wednesday afternoon to increase IAB members' understanding of accreditation processes and to add to the pool of trained practitioner Visiting Team members. We also celebrate the life of Dr. James C. Smith with the award of the Mark Benjamin Lifetime Achievement Award. It is hoped that Sandra Smith will be able to receive the award in person in Orlando to honor the contributions Jim made to ACCE and to quality construction education throughout the country.

We had no responsive applicants this year for either the Dupree or the NHE/ACCE Scholarship programs. Similarly, we did not have an applicant for the Founders' Award. We ask for your help in attracting applicants for these awards with the goal of making appropriate awards next year to benefit the construction industry and to increase the recognition of ACCE.

ACCE continues our long history of bringing quality education to the programs, students, and parents who are investing in the development of the future generation of professionals in the construction industry. Our important role is to insure that graduates possess the rigorous competencies that are current, consistent, and needed by this critical sector of the national economy. Without the contributions of your time, resources, and leadership talent, ACCE cannot continue to fulfill this role. I thank you again for your efforts in accomplishing all of these important goals.
