The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for 4-year Baccalaureate Degree programs, two-year Associate Degree programs, and Master Degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology. The Council offers Recognition of Continuing Education courses for Non-Degree Programs.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor's professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China, the Canadian Technology Accreditation Board (CTAB), and The Chartered Institute of Builders (CIOB) in the United Kingdom. The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs and Master Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards' comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.

Greetings:

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, it is a privilege to present the American Council for Construction Education Annual Report.

We are grateful for the vision and leadership of our past chair, Al Hauck, who continues to be a strong leader and mentor with ACCE. With the same vision, our Board of Trustees and ACCE teams have been working diligently through a very active period with governance, new standards, accreditation, marketing and strategic planning, awards, and our industry advisory board partnerships.

Recommended governance changes implemented include a diverse trustee selection process. The Leadership Development Committee researched, compiled and distributed a comprehensive matrix of experience desired for ACCE leadership positions. The Board of Trustees welcomes two association members: The National Association of Home Builders renewed support for ACCE appointing Greg Zick as its representative. Thank you Greg for your commitment and passion for what ACCE brings to the residential builders. The Roofing Industry Alliance for Progress appointed Bill Good as its association representative. Welcome Bill to ACCE.

The Accreditation Committee reports that all programs are now being assessed against the new Outcome Based Standards that were developed with industry. Guidance, Standards, Council of Chairs, and Training continue to refine documentation and provide ongoing education, training, mentoring, and support.

Our Marketing Task Force spent six months exploring who and what ACCE is to its stakeholders and what they would like to see improved. The Task Force is now working with Joy Svoboda and her firm ViewsValuesVisions to design marketing strategies and marketing materials to reach contingent stakeholders. The Task Force, led by Al Hauck, includes Susan Labas, Robert Ries, Drew Yantis, John Schaufelberger,

James Hogan, Brian Wasserman, and Mike Holland.

Recognizing the importance of marketing and the major focus of the Strategic Plan, the Board approved the transition of the Development Committee to the Marketing and Communications Committee. Susan Labas, with her marketing background and experience with ACCE has been asked to chair the committee, with Al Hauck and Brian Wasserman as co-chairs, along with members of the Marketing Task Force. Susan has accepted the challenge.

The charge of the Marketing and Communications Committee is to maintain the marketing plan, update it every three years, and oversee the structure and content of the ACCE website. With the Committee working with Joy Svoboda and her firm, ACCE is on the precipice of an exciting marketing journey. This includes the challenge to engage the Board and all ACCE stakeholders to reach out to their construction industries and academic communities and carry our message of rigor and excellence in education. We must emphasize the role of industry in establishing our accreditation standards and the quality of graduates of ACCE-accredited programs.

The Industry Liaison Committee chaired by Charles McIntyre continues to host the annual Industry Advisory Board (IAB) Workshops. The IAB Workshop continues to be one of the most informative, well attended events attracting large numbers of industry representatives and program leaders. The IAB Workshop in its 9th year recognizes that a strong IAB means a strong accredited construction education program, and encourages industry participation. The IAB Workshop is held each February one day before the ACCE mid-year meeting.

In 2017, two prestigious awards were presented. The ACCE Mark Benjamin Lifetime Achievement Award honored the late Dr. James Smith for his service and commitment to quality construction education. Leslie Fei-

genbaum accepted the award on behalf of Jim's wife Sandy. The Founder's Award recognized Bob Bowen of Bowen Engineering who has had a profound impact on construction education. Bob remains a loyal supporter of ACCE.

ACCE awarded 2 scholarships during this fiscal year: Alfredo Reyes from Arizona State received \$5,000 for the Dupree Scholarship and Jared Burgoon from Colorado State received \$5,000 from the NHE Dupree Scholarship. Both deserving gentlemen will continue to foster quality education by being faculty members of ACCE accredited programs.

The Board of Trustees is pleased to report that we now have 73 4-year, 13 2-year, and 5 Masters degree accredited programs and 15 candidate programs representing 4- and 2- year programs (9 + 6). ACCE continues to be seen as the go-to accreditor, bringing the value of a rigorous and well respected accreditation.

It is with the support of the President Mike Holland, Executive Assistant Billye Hall, past Chair Al Hauck, Vice Chair John Schaufelberger, the Officers and Board of Trustees, chairs and members of committees, task forces, and caucuses, and hundreds of dedicated volunteers that ACCE continues to be the strong and recognized accreditor for construction education since 1974, raising the standards of excellence through industry and academic partnerships.

Your participation is important to ACCE, and we ask you to approach us with your questions and interest in volunteering to ultimately ensure graduates continue to achieve the competencies needed in this critical construction sector of the economy.

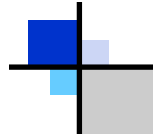
